Kathy presented the treasurer's report.

Grants: We did \$4,519.00 in grants to St Pts/Bridgid Food Pantry, All Saint's, St Pats/Bridgid little leprechauns, and the Fowler HS Booster Club.

Janice went over the calendar and stated sales have been good. Always looking for more pictures. A newsletter should go out in March.

Janice went over the police monument. Work on the statute itself is progressing and we hope to have it soon. We do have a deadline of April so it is set for the second anniversary.

Shamrock Run- we are good with volunteers but Eileen put out a call for race day volunteers as we may get quite a few on race day, especially if the weather is good. Grand Marshall is Ally Walker, who painted our mural and is a Tipp Hill resident. Post card to be mailed on 2/16 to all Tipp Hill houses. Currently 1300 people have registered so far.

No report from Syracuse Police.

Block Grant Challenge- Michelle Skarpanski from City Hall went over the Block Grants so far. 211 properties on Tipp Hill/Salt Springs and of that about 110 were Tipp Hill specific. 1st phase needs to be done by 6/30/26 and homeowners can participate 3 times during a 5-year period. In the spring bigger projects will become eligible. Grants can be stacked with other grants and this is encouraged. \$75,000 is the max match amount of any project.

HHQ-2 of the 4 new houses are sold, one is still under construction.

Dev. Site- weather has slowed progress but things will pick up in the spring.

Pass Arboretum- more projects to come. Extra pavers will be incorporated into the new sidewalk to be done there.

Janice thanked the tree decorators that got the lights on the tree and wreaths up, along with our 2 traffic signs. It was noted that the tree stayed light all season by Dave.

Dave went over the Light up Tipp Hill contest. This year's winners received gift cards to Aurora Brewing Company.

The flag raising is set for 3/17 at Tipp Hill Memorial park. Our honoree is descendants of the Stone Throwers as this is the 100th anniversary of the light. We will also unveil our new historic marker from The Pomeroy Foundation.

We are making plans for a concert in Burnet Park during the summer. Will be a weeknight in June. More details to follow

From the floor: Tipp Hill Memorial park needs attention to the sink hole. City is aware of it and should address it this summer. Streets are getting narrow with the snowbanks pushing out into the road, streets are getting narrow. Janice to bring to the City's attention. Sidewalks are not being plowed. Report to Cityline so it can be addressed. Janice will also follow up with Donna Moore. Nov. yard waste was not done, Janice to follow up with City. Concert will be outside unless it is raining, then inside the rink.
